OVERVIEW






In 2019, there were sales of quasi-treasury stakes that account in total for 6.52%

As a result of the transactions, the Moscow Exchange increased free float of PJSC Gazprom's shares to 50%, making them the leader of the MSCI Russia index with a weight of 17.51% (as at 01 June 2020). This was beneficial for the Company's market capitalisation, with more passive investors guided by this index

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

CORPORATE GOVERNANCE



Expert RA rating agency carried out **an external assessment** of the corporate governance framework and assigned the Company **a national rating of governance quality**

An internal assessment of the Company's Board of Directors' and its Committees' performance was carried out through a questionnaire survey

An external assessment of the corporate governance framework – a comprehensive independent audit – was carried out by KPMG and Horizon CF



In 2021, Expert RA assessed the quality of the corporate governance and assigned the highest governance quality rating to PJSC Gazprom – A++.gq

INFORMATION DISCLOSURE


- Sustainability report prepared, taking into account expert recommendations received during the process of professional audit and public assurance






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ISO 45001:2018 requirements have been implemented. Corporate standards pertaining to the Integrated Process Safety Management System have been updated. The system has been certified to international standards




REDUCTION OF ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT (YEAR ON YEAR COMPARED TO 2019)*



- The number of ESG ratings increased from 5 in 2018 to 9 in 2020



EVOLUTION OF THE KEY ESG SCORES





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
